South African schools' rugby has a huge support base. There is enormous depth, intensity and skills development from the lower grades to the First XV. The schools selected here have produced a large number of Springboks. Of the 915 Springboks selected since 1906, just 20 schools have produced 329.

The schools (arranged in alphabetical order!) are: Afrikaanse Hoër Seunskool, Bishops, Boland Landbou, Dale College, Drostdy Technical High School, Glenwood HS, Grey College, Grey HS, Helpmekaar Kollege, Hilton College, Hoërskool Monument, Jeppe High School for Boys, King Edward VII School, Maritzburg College, Michaelhouse, Outeniqua HS, Paarl Boys' High, Hoërskool Gimnasium Paarl, Paul Roos Gymnasium, Queen's College Boys' High, Rondebosch Boys' High, SACS, Selborne College, St Andrew's College and Wynberg Boys' High.
